

INCOMING KINDERGARTEN SIBLINGS FOR FALL 2014

All Rocklin Academy families received an email last week regarding application instructions for incoming kindergarten siblings for the Fall 2014 school year.



If you have an incoming kindergarten sibling who wants to attend the Rocklin Academy Turnstone or Meyers campus, please follow the instructions included in the October 3rd email to submit your Kindergarten Sibling Application for the Fall 2014 school year.

Please remember that your sibling preference applies <u>only</u> to the campus where your current student attends, i.e., if you have a student attending the Meyers campus, you will complete a Meyers kindergarten sibling application; if you have a student attending Turnstone, you will complete a Turnstone kindergarten sibling application.

Please note that we are introducing a new online submission process for applications this year. The deadline to submit your kindergarten sibling application is 4 p.m. on Friday, October 25, 2013, to hold your child's spot in kindergarten for the Fall 2014 school year. The child must turn 5 years old on/before September 1, 2014 to apply for kindergarten. You will be required to upload a copy of his/her birth certificate at time of submission. If you are unable to upload the birth certificate, you must provide a copy of the birth certificate no later than 4 p.m. on October 25, 2013. We will not accept incomplete applications.
