

## STUDENT ABSENCES

If your child is absent, please call the absence line by 8:30am at (916) 632-6580 the day your child is absent. If you know your child will be out for more than one day (i.e., due to fever, flu diagnosis, travel, etc.), please state how many days you expect them to be absent.

### Please note per the Rocklin Academy Handbook:

- Children must be <u>fever free for 24 hours before returning to school</u> (fever is defined as 100° F or higher);
- Children awaiting results from a throat culture must remain at home until a negative result is known;
- Children with a positive strep culture must be treated with prescribed antibiotics for 24 hours before returning to school;
- Children that have been vomiting or have had diarrhea must remain home until the vomiting or diarrhea has stopped for 24 hours.

We ask that you partner with us by being vigilant in watching your child for any flu-like symptoms. Please do not send your child to school if he/she is running a fever or has any flu-like symptoms. This is for the safety of our students. We appreciate your help and thank you for helping keep all Rocklin Academy students healthy!
